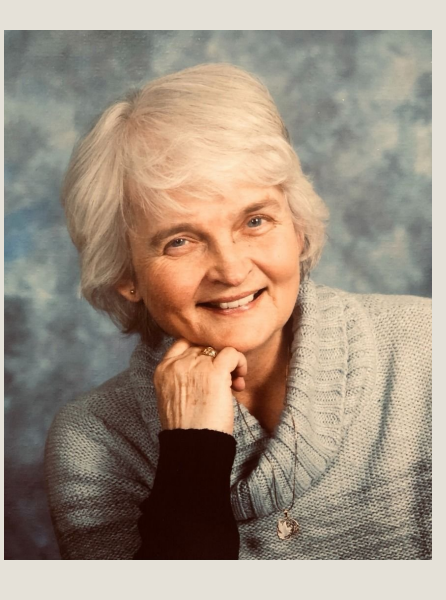




Linnie Elizabeth Gross
