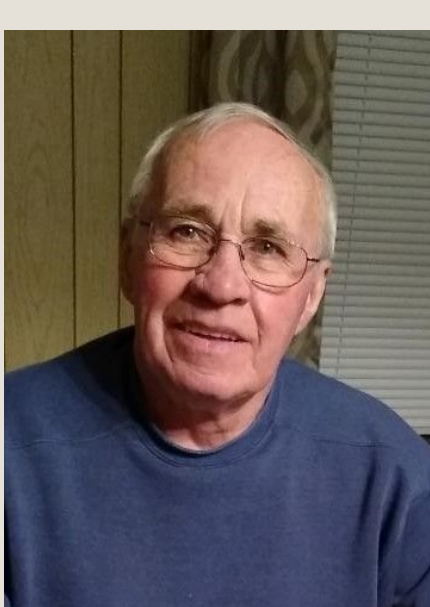




## Michael Edward Gallery
