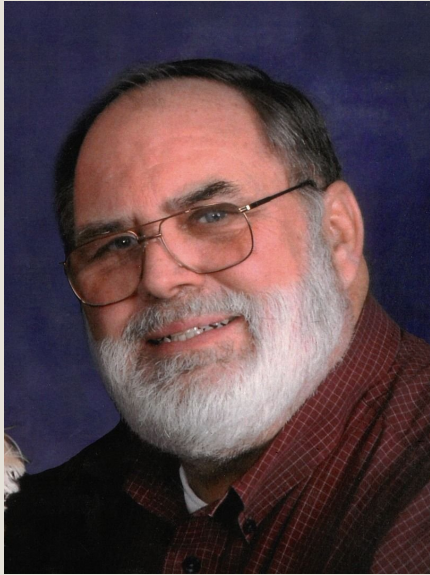




David Steiskal
