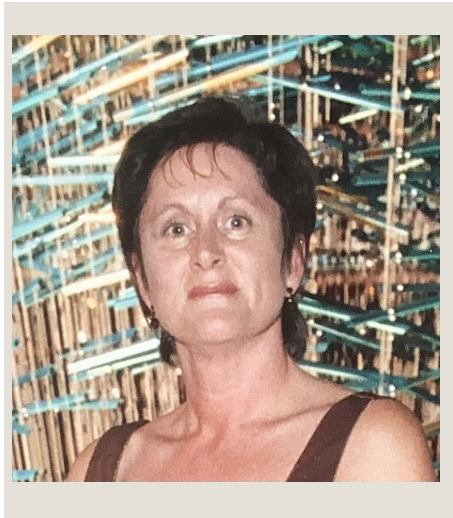




Mary Kathryn Graham
