Dan never sought attention, but his genuine nature often found him right in the center of any activity. People simply gravitated to him.

Dan was a man of the earth – a farmer, hunter, angler, teacher and mentor.

Dan dedicated his life and career to farming – potatoes, corn and other crops – eventually becoming a partner in Wingard Farms at Elk River. He also owned and operated Snow Control Services for the past 13 years.

He cultivated and planted wildlife food lots for deer, turkeys, and waterfowl on 100 acres of land he purchased for that reason. The acreage was equipped with many game cameras so he could observe and share photos of the wildlife that benefited from his labor of love.

While he was the best hunter and marksman in the group, Dan offered some of his hunting time to manage the annual family deer camp on his land to the delight of his sons, brothers, nephews, uncles, and friends, guiding them to many successful hunts.

He and Tracy provided generous hospitality for the group not only on opening weekend, but for many of the hunters, throughout the entire deer hunting season, with Dan balancing his overlapping work schedule of farming and snow removal.

Dan’s sons and friends also benefited from his conservation skills – hunting waterfowl, turkeys and upland game on the farm.

Losing Dan leaves a gap that only the memories of his presence and love can fill.
