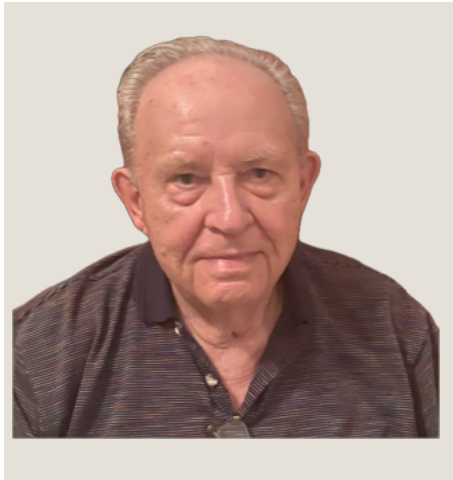




Richard M. Bailly

Richard M. Bailly, age 82, of Champlin, MN, was preceded in death by his parents, Marcel & Anna (Harildstad) Bailly; brothers, Leland and Raymond Bailly. He enlisted in the Navy in 1960 and subsequently completed the Naval Enlisted Scientific Education Program with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in 1972 at the University of Utah. He ultimately retired from the Navy at the rank of Lieutenant Commander in 1982.
