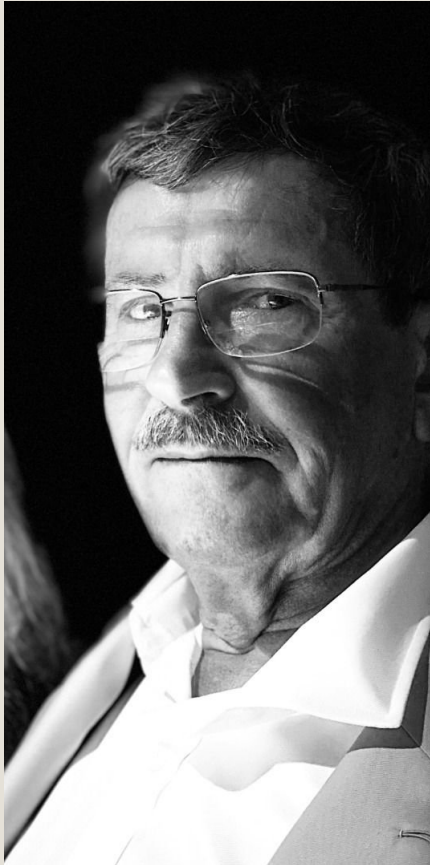




Samuel Erlandson
