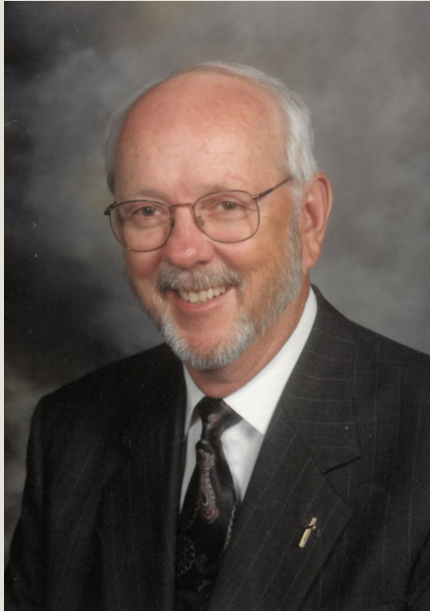




Bernard R. Dols
