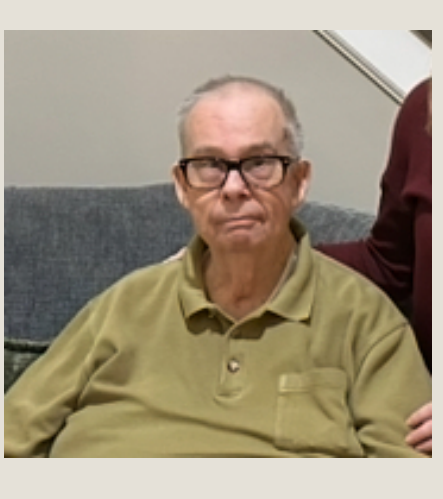




Edward R. Shamory
