Dennis's Catholic faith guided every part of his life. He embodied kindness, service, and gratitude. He lived each day with the belief that helping others was both a duty and a joy. His circle of friends—including lifelong companions Rosemary and Jaime Calva, Roy and Deb Hitchcock, and Buzz and Molly Anderson—became an extension of his family.
