Lone had a variety of jobs throughout her life. She began as a teacher, worked in a nursing home, and in real estate. Many of her years were spent in the insurance industry. Often, she held two jobs to support her family. She retired from Met Life as an underwriter. Lone had many interests and hobbies over the years.
